## VICE PRESIDENT – Nick Dreher (ND) ND Reported:

- Cassie will be sending out updated Bylaws Responses due 14<sup>th</sup>, final vote on update is in February
- Discussion of ages included on bylaws amendment to be sent out for board review, up to commissioners to determine development of a team based on number of players at an age group. Protecting kids that sit on the bubble between age groups
- Discussion of streamlining sponsorship for All-Stars because teams seem to be hitting up the same businesses
- Nick to put out a list of what is needed re: all-stars from each commissioner
- TO REMAIN ON MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY VOTE:
- All-Stars Organization Update
  - Cleaned up the bylaw
  - Added "All players must have played in spring SABA season"
  - Added birthdate cutoff
  - Added commissioner liaison (assigning role to VP)
  - Added nomination of coach in November to make this an annual structure and allow for indoor workout planning
  - Added that you cannot compile your list of potential players until after spring baseball registration, meaning spring registrants need to have the option to play in all-stars.
  - *Must have home tournament*
  - All expenses must be covered by each team or by collecting fees. Added \$200 fee per team due prior to first outdoor practice. This will be to cover the chalk/field dry/maintenance issues that come up that league incurs the expense for by allowing teams to play.
  - SABA will cover insurance as it does currently.
  - Uniforms must follow SABA branding
  - All else the same
- Put together FAQ sheet for Age Changes and All-Stars to add to the website to give all information in detail
  - Discussion about future confusion about age discrepancy between in-house and all-star age cutoff with possible public confusion

## New Business Not Noted Elsewhere & Open Forum:

- Registration Details:
  - o All set on website could combine Tball if we want to
  - Cassie to email registrants that it is opening on Monday
  - Kevin re: Advertising: will not be able to use Primary and Intermediate to hand out flyers so will use the difference for social media advertising
  - Cassie to order 200 from Ace Brothers in January
  - Will wait to see what happens with shutdowns in January before booking evaluations
  - Will offer sizers at evaluations and not have in-person registration. Offer to accept cash at evaluations or another time.
- Will do an equipment swap or have donated cleats and other items for those who need them at evaluations
- Capital Improvement Budget Update

- Minor Field Overhaul \$12,000, came in at \$11,835, got more work done than was initially quoted & they went above and beyond, did a great job.
- Batting Cage Overhaul \$3,000, came in at \$2,027 before turf
  - 4 L Screens, Netting, Cable, turning 2 cages into 4
  - Consider rubber on the back end of the cage
- Field Signage \$2,000
- Paint \$500
- Legion Field Maintenance \$1,000, came in at \$156
- Golf Cart Overhaul \$1,500
  - Total budgeted \$20,000, to date we have spent \$14,410.
