MONTHLY UPDATE – Jamie McSwaney (JM) JM Reported:

- Penn United would like to use the fields for an employee outing
- Rawlings Tigers baseball (AAU Group) building a new facility but want to rent our field while it is being built. 2 hours/\$45/hour on Saturday nights.
- Baseballs and scorebooks distributed at pictures
- Opening Day Saturday. Weather is extremely questionable.
 - Discussion to move the entire day's schedule to May 15th
 - Will decide by Friday afternoon

TREASURER'S REPORT – Erika Allison (EA) EA Reported:

- Savings: \$5,745
- Concessions: \$800
- Investment: \$20,479.64
- General Checking: \$46,560
- Total of all accounts: \$90,156
- Uniform invoices coming in, have all except Bronco and Colt
- Lots of expenses this month to start the season
 - Golf cart
 - Baseballs \$2500
 - Jefferson Twp Dumpster - \$1,491
 - Sponsorship Signs - \$1,385
 - Lots of tournament activity in and out
- 2021 UMPIRE COSTS: \$5,659
 - Minor: \$17 plate, \$13 base ump (\$30/game) – umped by Bronco and Pony players = 24 games x \$30 = \$720
 - Bronco: 52 games @ \$50 each (16 Dreher / 18 Schultz / 18 Pelloni) = \$1,239
 - Pony: 20 games @ \$55 each = \$2,600
 - Colt: \$1,100
 - Farm: Can use Bronco/Pony players to umpire playoffs if desired

CONCESSIONS – Cassie Beres (CB) CB Reported:

- All-Stars meeting went well and all teams are set with dates and concession managers

- \$758 from 11U tournament, paid team \$109.20
- Lots of expenses including cheese machine, hot dog machine, propane, new fire extinguishers
- New tables are in
- Freezer in lower stand died, \$151 in losses – EA to see about a replacement if not we will use the one in the upper stand
- Scheduling issues – rule change to include no opt out after schedule is out
- League wide VSF checks collected
