 - Vote to change name pending research and league survey. 9 YAY 0 NAY
- Age Change Issue
 - Pony International Baseball has officially changed their age back to the April 30 cutoff. ARL has adopted this age change, contradicting the catch-up age we just moved to in 2021.

- o Consider following grade-then-age as we do for All-Stars, it will align age cutoffs with All-Stars and in-
- Consider staying with current age, will expose younger kids of those playing ages to more competitive baseball.
- o Proposal to implement for Bronco and up
- o Vote to abide by April 30th cutoff with Grade first then Age supercedes grade. JM Propose, ND second.
 - Unanimous 9 YAY, 0 NAY.
- Proposal to amend bylaws to alleviate future age change deliberations:
 - SABA will follow the predetermined grade-then-age cutoff for team eligibility. Saxonburg will
 adhere to Pony International Age Standards or whichever national body is mandating the
 league that we are playing in for Bronco and Up.
- Going into registration, consideration for any potential exception requests and rules surrounding those. Discussion of these with all commissioners prior to registration opening in December.
- Registration will open Sunday, December 18th and close Monday, February 20th.
 - Same rates but \$40 mandatory fundraiser
 - Concession opt-out will be \$100
