MONTHLY UPDATE -

JD reported:

Scoreboard on legion field (purchased by Seven Seas) is up and running. Sponsors are needed. Would like to have small, local businesses advertise – may offer these businesses a lower cost or no cost, to support the community. Seven Seas will have large advertisement at the top of the board.

JD motioned for Angela Shoop to fill the IT support position. Motion was seconded. Angie will be the new IT/Web support representative.

TREASURER'S REPORT - Cassie Beres:

New fiscal year began October 1.

September report—there are a few checks outstanding. Upcoming expenses: Dumpster cost, sponsor signs, porta john fee.

\$7,606 for concession deposited...total concession is \$14,788.

Yearly financials – Discussion about money funneled for the Dan Schroeder corn hole tournament/benefit/fundraiser. \$21,619 was raised and provided for the family. \$35,000 machine purchased. Registration was up this year.

All Star info: We have a small games of chance license. 60 percent of what the team makes/fundraises should be spent within that year unless there is a plan for that money.

CONCESSIONS – Ali Ciz (AC):

JD reported:

Trying to sell leftover water and Gatorade to Spartans football organization. Awaiting to hear from them. New lock put on upper concession stand due to key being lost. Renovations are moving along. Still pursuing larger concession stand for down below. JD and MH met with Mill Iron to discuss options and pricing. Recommendation made for a pole

building, but rough-cut shed may be more feasible. Need for a permit must be looked into. Rough cut shed estimate is \$5,500 for 12x30. Current shed is 12x20. Due to losing storage space at upper concession stand due to bathroom renovations, a larger shed (16x34) may be needed. Lots to consider: digging, necessity of pad, moving of old stand, ambulance access, etc.

Concrete update for farm and t ball field dugouts: MH and JD met with concrete company – 26 yards of concrete needed for both dugouts on t ball, both dugouts on farm, with an estimated cost of \$16000-\$18000, which includes the cost of labor. Due to high cost, other options need to be considered: turf beads, plywood, artificial grass/indoor-outdoor carpet, etc.

JD proposes that we wait to vote for all-star coaches in January and run coaching January to January, rather than October to October.

Would like to see increased communication between all-star coaches and the board.
